Overview

The AFU Budget Committee is an advisory group consisting of the President, a representative from the College of Business Administration and the Finance Manager. The committee's main duty is to establish funding recommendations based on the university's strategic plan. Other duties include reviewing budget proposals and university needs for the Library, IT Center, manpower, maintenance, professional development, community engagement and scientific research. Analyzing budget reduction plans and developing funding initiatives.

Responsibilities

1. Consider AFU's financial policy, strategy and planning and make recommendations to the Chancellor
2. Assess the annual budget and budget review
3. Analyze financial forecasts
4. Consider student tuition fees and endorse changes as appropriate
5. Regard the financial sustainability of capital development projects in the context of AFU's annual and projected budgets
